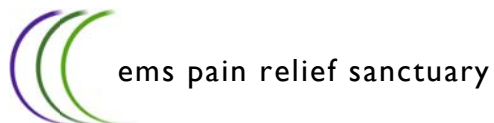

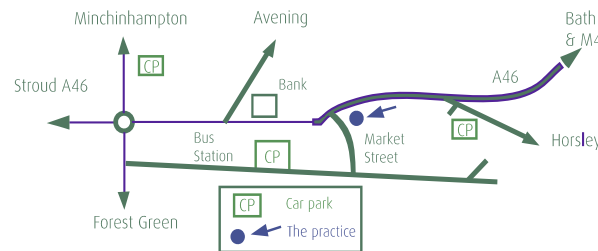

Frequently Asked Questions (by patients)

Q Is the equipment safe?

A Yes, it's very safe. Up until the year 2001, over 10,000 people had been evaluated whilst using Viofor EMS therapy equipment with no evidence of side effects.

Q What happens when I go on the equipment - what will I feel?

A Most people feel nothing more than slight warmth from the equipment. Occasionally, minor tingling sensations are felt in the extremities or other areas of the body. People with painful conditions can have a slight increase in the amount of pain that they feel, but this will only last for one to three sessions. After this the analgesic effect of the equipment starts to work and pain is very much lessened. Many people report a feeling of well-being after just a few treatments

Q How long before I start to get benefit from the equipment?

A This will depend upon which condition is being treated. Age and fitness also play a part in how quickly you will react to treatments.

Q How well do Chronic ailments respond to EMS therapy?

Chronic ailments such as MS and Parkinson's will normally respond well, with varying times and levels of relief, depending upon the severity of the condition before treatment commences.

Q Can I continue to take medication whilst using the equipment?

A Yes. Our equipment is designed to be used as an adjunctive therapy to normal medical procedures, so we recommend that you continue to use prescribed medications and follow the advice of your doctor /consultant. If you are chronically ill, we recommend that you inform your medical practitioner that you will be having EMS therapy.

EMS Treatment Today

The actual treatment takes place on electromagnetic bed and split into two parts. During the first part the whole body is treated on a full bed. During the second part most affected body part is selected and specialized smaller appliance is used.

One session takes around half an hour. The person treated stays fully clothed throughout. The treatment is totally painless and free of any side effects, and it is safe because no foreign bodies are introduced and the magnetic induction is low.

We believe that the JPS System we use is the only clinically tried and tested therapy available on the market today that does not produce negative side effects, making it the most effective way of creating a better quality of life by vastly improve mobility, reduce pain and swelling of individual joints in a natural side effect free way. Provision of substantial pain relief accompanies the treatment for many conditions.

The benefits of the JPS Viofor treatments include improved pain and bladder control, mobility (numbness and stiffness), balance and vision. To further compound the JPS Viofor treatment Crystal Light Therapy is also available, to enhance the hypothalamus to strengthen the neuron pathway connections already gained by JPS Viofor treatment.
